## 'Hi-Def Hoodlum' Wanted by Authorities

Multiple warrants issued for man accused of stealing flat-screen TVs

**COLUMBUS**, **OH**—Columbus City Attorney Richard C. Pfeiffer, Jr. announced that Paul Jeffrey Waginger, a 26 year old convicted felon, is the latest "Fugitive of the Week." Three arrest warrants and an additional active case were filed against Waginger after he allegedly committed a series of thefts during a two-week crime spree late last year. He has evaded authorities since then.

"We are hoping the public can help provide information on the whereabouts of this individual," said City Attorney Richard C. Pfeiffer, Jr.

On December 2, 2013 Waginger stole a 39" Samsung TV valued at \$429.99 from a store at the Graceland Shopping Center.

On December 12, 2013 Waginger stole a 32" *Philips* TV valued at \$259.99 from an Easton-area retailer. Two days later, Waginger struck again at the same location. According to reports, Waginger careened his vehicle into a handicap parking space, jumped out, grabbed a shopping cart and then entered the store. Approximately ten minutes later, surveillance cameras caught him placing a *Nikon* digital camera valued at \$599.99 and a \$79.99 *Bright Starts* baby swing in his cart and walking out of the store.

As store security approached him, Waginger initiated a scuffle. During the brief melee, Waginger lost his coat, hat, and sunglasses before breaking free and running away. He called the store a few hours later to ask if he could pick up his personal belongings at the lost-and-found department. The vehicle he left parked in the handicap parking space was impounded.

The next day, Waginger targeted another Easton-area retailer, stealing items valued at \$393.88, including a 38" *Vizio* soundbar system.

"It would be poetic justice if having Mr. Waginger's image broadcast on flat-screen TVs all across central Ohio helps lead to his arrest," said Assistant City Prosecutor Bill R. Hedrick, who leads the fugitive apprehension program on City Attorney Pfeiffer's behalf.

Waginger's past criminal record includes incarceration for drug-related felonies as well as charges of breaking and entering, receiving stolen property, resisting arrest, contempt of court, hit-skip, leaving the scene of an accident, and OVI.
